Architecture Firm Enjoys Recent Real-Estate Surge

The Wall Street Journal last week labeled Aspen the most expensive town in America, and **Brewster McLeod Architects Inc.** (www.brewstermcLeod.com) says it is working to capitalize on this designation.

This year, a 14,000-square-foot home designed by architect **Jamie L. Brewster McLeod** closed in Pyramid Point Estates. In addition, the Aspen firm recently released drawings for an 11,900-square-foot home in a nearby subdivision that went under contract prior to construction.

Both designs have pushed **Brewster McLeod Architects** to reach beyond the conventional mountain-home style to create projects that inspire worldwide attention, the firm says, adding that its talent in the luxury residential market has proven to be a hot seller in this niche community.
